## Freezing the world

### Your best bits

In 1908 a photograph could take a week to produce. You would go to a studio, pose for a portrait and pay money to a photographer who would also develop the black and white image.

In 2008 most people have hundreds of images of themselves, their family, friends, hobbies and holidays. Most are digital. It takes less than a second to take the picture and see it on a colour screen.

So how is your life recorded in images? Pick six images that tell the story of your life. Build these into a simple presentation. You may want to include captions for the images. Think about where to place these. They can be:

- Outside the image.
- In the image - but put a colour background behind it so that the text shows up. White text on a black background usually looks best.

You can collect some images over the next week. Ask to see some your family or friends might have. You could also collect some from the internet if they show your hobbies or things you are interested in.

Next week you will have to bring these images into school and make your presentation.
